



Financial Aid Application

The Seacoast United Field Hockey Club (SUSC) offers a financial aid program for those players who are in need of financial assistance in order to play field hockey. The program is open to all youth players who wish to play field hockey at Seacoast United for its Travel Team or Developmental Academy Programs and is based on financial need only and not playing ability. The form included in this packet must be completed and you must submit all documentation listed below that will help the Financial Aid Committee, more accurately, determine your need.

Uniform / Training Gear & Administration Fees are not covered by financial aid (\$350).

Your application is taken very seriously by the SUSC Financial Aid Committee and will be dealt with in a confidential manner. This information will be reviewed only by the SUSC Financial Aid Committee and the Club Administration.

Types of Financial Aid:

1. Payment Plan: This is not a financial aid award and does not reduce the tuition due to the club by the family. Instead it allows the family to pay fees on a schedule that is customized to your family budget and is different from the payment schedule as listed on the Payment forms and contracts. Payment plans should be arranged by contacting Katie White immediately (kwhite@seacoastunited.org). *No forms or financial documentation are necessary to set up a payment plan.*

2. Financial Aid: The aid that a family can receive ranges from 10% to 100% excluding uniform / training gear and administration fees. In order to be considered for Financial Aid the following must be sent to the SUFH Financial Aid Committee:

- 1) Fill out the attached Financial Aid Application.
- 2) Attach a copy of parents/guardians* latest W-2's and last years' Federal Tax Return.

All families receiving Financial Aid are expected to volunteer 10 hours per season to help SUFH provide the best field hockey program in New England. These hours may include volunteering for administration duties, field maintenance, fundraising or any other capacity deemed appropriate by the Club. Note-All financial aid recipients will be expected to help coordinate the SUFH indoor tournament on February 26th, 2012. SUFH will also expect some mentoring of the younger age groups at Seacoast. Example - a U19 player, will be asked to spend time with the U10/U12/U14/16 age groups.

* Financial Assistance will be based off of the financial need of the parents / guardians of the player.
