



The Covid-19 Facility Plan has been designed to allow for maximum social/physical distancing while attending games, and tournament/jamboree events at the Back River Sports Complex in Bedford, NH.

Foot traffic will flow in one-way patterns as much as possible. While waiting for games to begin, or for family to pick up, players are asked to follow social distancing guidelines within the designated areas located on either side of the playing fields.

Face coverings are required while at the complex. Players and coaches may remove face coverings during games. Playing areas/field surfaces are designated for coaches and players only. Spectator areas are marked on the field map in purple, and signs will be marking the space near each field.



Parents and spectators are asked to respect and adhere to social/physical distancing guidelines. Only 1 spectator per athlete please. SUSC asks all spectators not to approach the playing area as it will reduce the group size allowance guidelines for games. Face coverings must be worn during your stay at the complex.



Practice good hygiene, wash hands regularly with soap & water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water is not available, please use hand sanitizer.
