

Field Use Guidelines:

- The Use of alcoholic beverages and smoking is forbidden in and on school premises at all times
- All organizations must comply with applicable national, state, and local regulations & ordinances, including and not limited to requirements of the Manchester Police & Fire Departments
- Applicable permits are the renting organization's responsibility
- No dogs to be allowed on track or turf fields at any time during event
- Food vendors must be pre-approved and have permit from Health Department
- Use of sound system & scoreboard must have prior approval from school district and must be written on field
 permit
- Use of all district athletic equipment must have prior approval from school district, and be written on field permit.
- All organizations must supervise and conduct an event in a responsible manner which leaves the school facility in the same condition as it was before the event, excluding normal wear & tear
 - No bikes, roller blades, skate boards, inside fenced area
 - No truck tires, dumbbells/weights on track or turf field
 - o No cleats on track
 - No baseball cleats on turf field or track
 - No driving or hammering any objects into the turf field, i.e., stake tie-downs
 - o No tents/canopies on track or turf field
 - All tents/canopies outside fence must be secured
 - No food, gum, sunflower seeds on track or turf field
 - No fire works to be launched on field
 - Clean up area after event

NOTE:

Field attendant at any given event has total discretion or final authority on field use during any given event, and can stop any unsafe or damaging activity

Manchester School district reserves the right to limit or revoke the reservation of any organization upon finding that the organization breached Terms of Use of the School Facilities Rental Agreement at any time
